Not every dog is appropriate for group play. Some dogs may require a test day to see if your dog is a good candidate for playgroups. Dogs who display aggression or are uncomfortable with others in play sessions will be removed from such interactions. **The staff reserves the right to remove a dog from group play for any reason.**

Play groups will be carefully conducted and supervised by our staff. If any injury should occur during group interactions you may be financially responsible for any medical attention the veterinarian on staff deems appropriate. Every dog reacts differently and animals, by nature, are unpredictable and, therefore, present a certain level of risk. We will attempt to contact you at the emergency phone number(s) provided in the event of an injury. However, medical attention will be administered regardless of whether or not we are able to reach you.

Please be aware that filling out our questionnaire does not automatically qualify your dog to be part of group play. Our staff will evaluate each dog on a case by case basis.

By signing below, I acknowledge:

- I have read this information and authorize play group socialization for my dog.
- I acknowledge and understand the risk of injury resulting from group play, including but not limited to nicks, nips or scratches from rough play or aggression, and may be held financially responsible for any injuries that may occur to my dog, or for injuries to other dogs inflicted by my dog.
- If no appropriate playmates are available, we may substitute individual playtime for group play.
- I certify the accuracy of all the information I have provided about my dog.
- I certify that my dog is free from illness, parasites or any communicable disease, and has not been treated for such in the last 30 days
